A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning elections.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing
5 Section 7-6 as follows:

6 (10 ILCS 5/7-6) (from Ch. 46, par. 7-6)

7 Sec. 7-6. The ~~The~~ expense of conducting each primary,
8 including the per diem of judges, furnishing, warming,
9 lighting and maintaining the polling place, and all other
10 expenses necessarily incurred in the preparation for or
11 conducting such primary shall be paid in the same manner, and
12 by the same authorities or officers as provided in Sections
13 17-30 through 17-32 of this Code.
