625 ILCS 5/3-806.75 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that the standard registration fee for electric vehicles shall be waived for any vehicle owner who is a volunteer firefighter or emergency services personnel. Provides that the new provisions do not apply to the fee set forth for electric vehicles.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding
Section 3-806.75 as follows:

- (625 ILCS 5/3-806.75 new) 6 7 Sec. 3-806.75. Registration fees for volunteer firemen and emergency medical services personnel. 8 9 (a) Beginning with the first registration year commencing after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 102nd 10 General Assembly, the standard registration fee set forth in 11 Section 3-806 for passenger motor vehicles of the first 12 division and motor vehicles of the second division weighing 13
- 14 not more than 8,000 pounds and registered under Section 3-815 15 shall be waived for any Illinois vehicle owner who is a 16 volunteer firefighter or emergency medical services personnel. 17 (b) This Section does not apply to the fee set forth in
- 18 <u>Section 3-805 for electric vehicles.</u>
