SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

215 ILCS 5/356z.48

Amends the Illinois Insurance Code. Provides that a group or individual policy of accident and health insurance or managed care plan amended, delivered, issued, or renewed on or after January 1, 2024 shall provide coverage for a colonoscopy determined to be medically necessary for persons aged 39 years old to 75 years old.

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by renumbering and changing Section 356z.43, as added by Public
- 6 Act 102-443, as follows:

- 8 Sec. 356z.48 356z.43. Colonoscopy coverage.
- 9 (a) A group policy of accident and health insurance that
- is amended, delivered, issued, or renewed on or after January
- 11 1, 2022 shall provide coverage for a colonoscopy that is a
- 12 follow-up exam based on an initial screen where the
- 13 colonoscopy was determined to be medically necessary by a
- 14 physician licensed to practice medicine in all its branches,
- 15 an advanced practice registered nurse, or a physician
- 16 assistant.
- 17 (b) A group or individual policy of accident and health
- insurance or managed care plan amended, delivered, issued, or
- renewed on or after January 1, 2024 shall provide coverage for
- a colonoscopy determined to be medically necessary for persons
- 21 aged 39 years old to 75 years old.
- 22 (c) (b) A policy subject to this Section shall not impose a
- 23 deductible, coinsurance, copayment, or any other cost-sharing

- 1 requirement on the coverage provided; except that this
- 2 subsection does not apply to coverage of colonoscopies to the
- 3 extent such coverage would disqualify a high-deductible health
- 4 plan from eligibility for a health savings account pursuant to
- 5 Section 223 of the Internal Revenue Code.
