

## 102ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2021 and 2022 HB5362

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

210 ILCS 85/6.33 new

Amends the Hospital Licensing Act. Provides that hospitals licensed under the Act are prohibited from preventing the administration of a prescription medication to a patient if the patient's treating physician has prescribed the medication.

- **represented in the General Assembly:**
- 4 Section 5. The Hospital Licensing Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 6.33 as follows:
- 6 (210 ILCS 85/6.33 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 6.33. Prescription medication; administration to</u>
- 8 patients. A hospital licensed under this Act is prohibited
- 9 <u>from preventing the administration of a prescription</u>
- 10 medication to a patient if the patient's treating physician
- 11 <u>has prescribed the medication.</u>
