

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding  
5 Section 5.970 as follows:

6 (30 ILCS 105/5.970 new)

7 Sec. 5.970. The Future Farmers of America Fund.

8 Section 10. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by  
9 changing Section 3-699.14 as follows:

10 (625 ILCS 5/3-699.14)

11 Sec. 3-699.14. Universal special license plates.

12 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the  
13 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and  
14 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may  
15 issue Universal special license plates to residents of  
16 Illinois on behalf of organizations that have been authorized  
17 by the General Assembly to issue decals for Universal special  
18 license plates. Appropriate documentation, as determined by  
19 the Secretary, shall accompany each application. Authorized  
20 organizations shall be designated by amendment to this  
21 Section. When applying for a Universal special license plate

1 the applicant shall inform the Secretary of the name of the  
2 authorized organization from which the applicant will obtain a  
3 decal to place on the plate. The Secretary shall make a record  
4 of that organization and that organization shall remain  
5 affiliated with that plate until the plate is surrendered,  
6 revoked, or otherwise cancelled. The authorized organization  
7 may charge a fee to offset the cost of producing and  
8 distributing the decal, but that fee shall be retained by the  
9 authorized organization and shall be separate and distinct  
10 from any registration fees charged by the Secretary. No decal,  
11 sticker, or other material may be affixed to a Universal  
12 special license plate other than a decal authorized by the  
13 General Assembly in this Section or a registration renewal  
14 sticker. The special plates issued under this Section shall be  
15 affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division,  
16 including motorcycles and autocycles, or motor vehicles of the  
17 second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates  
18 issued under this Section shall expire according to the  
19 multi-year procedure under Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

20 (b) The design, color, and format of the Universal special  
21 license plate shall be wholly within the discretion of the  
22 Secretary. Universal special license plates are not required  
23 to designate "Land of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection  
24 (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The design shall allow for  
25 the application of a decal to the plate. Organizations  
26 authorized by the General Assembly to issue decals for

1 Universal special license plates shall comply with rules  
2 adopted by the Secretary governing the requirements for and  
3 approval of Universal special license plate decals. The  
4 Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow Universal  
5 special license plates to be issued as vanity or personalized  
6 plates in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The  
7 Secretary of State must make a version of the special  
8 registration plates authorized under this Section in a form  
9 appropriate for motorcycles and autocycles.

10 (c) When authorizing a Universal special license plate,  
11 the General Assembly shall set forth whether an additional fee  
12 is to be charged for the plate and, if a fee is to be charged,  
13 the amount of the fee and how the fee is to be distributed.  
14 When necessary, the authorizing language shall create a  
15 special fund in the State treasury into which fees may be  
16 deposited for an authorized Universal special license plate.  
17 Additional fees may only be charged if the fee is to be paid  
18 over to a State agency or to a charitable entity that is in  
19 compliance with the registration and reporting requirements of  
20 the Charitable Trust Act and the Solicitation for Charity Act.  
21 Any charitable entity receiving fees for the sale of Universal  
22 special license plates shall annually provide the Secretary of  
23 State a letter of compliance issued by the Attorney General  
24 verifying that the entity is in compliance with the Charitable  
25 Trust Act and the Solicitation for Charity Act.

26 (d) Upon original issuance and for each registration

1 renewal period, in addition to the appropriate registration  
2 fee, if applicable, the Secretary shall collect any additional  
3 fees, if required, for issuance of Universal special license  
4 plates. The fees shall be collected on behalf of the  
5 organization designated by the applicant when applying for the  
6 plate. All fees collected shall be transferred to the State  
7 agency on whose behalf the fees were collected, or paid into  
8 the special fund designated in the law authorizing the  
9 organization to issue decals for Universal special license  
10 plates. All money in the designated fund shall be distributed  
11 by the Secretary subject to appropriation by the General  
12 Assembly.

13 (e) The following organizations may issue decals for  
14 Universal special license plates with the original and renewal  
15 fees and fee distribution as follows:

16 (1) The Illinois Department of Natural Resources.

17 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the  
18 Roadside Monarch Habitat Fund and \$15 to the Secretary  
19 of State Special License Plate Fund.

20 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Roadside Monarch  
21 Habitat Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of State Special  
22 License Plate Fund.

23 (2) Illinois Veterans' Homes.

24 (A) Original issuance: \$26, which shall be  
25 deposited into the Illinois Veterans' Homes Fund.

26 (B) Renewal: \$26, which shall be deposited into

1 the Illinois Veterans' Homes Fund.

2 (3) The Illinois Department of Human Services for  
3 volunteerism decals.

4 (A) Original issuance: \$25, which shall be  
5 deposited into the Secretary of State Special License  
6 Plate Fund.

7 (B) Renewal: \$25, which shall be deposited into  
8 the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

9 (4) The Illinois Department of Public Health.

10 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the  
11 Prostate Cancer Awareness Fund and \$15 to the  
12 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

13 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Prostate Cancer  
14 Awareness Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of State  
15 Special License Plate Fund.

16 (5) Horsemen's Council of Illinois.

17 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the  
18 Horsemen's Council of Illinois Fund and \$15 to the  
19 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

20 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Horsemen's  
21 Council of Illinois Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of  
22 State Special License Plate Fund.

23 (6) K9s for Veterans, NFP.

24 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the  
25 Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Awareness Fund and \$15  
26 to the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

1 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Post-Traumatic  
2 Stress Disorder Awareness Fund and \$2 to the Secretary  
3 of State Special License Plate Fund.

4 (7) The International Association of Machinists and  
5 Aerospace Workers.

6 (A) Original issuance: \$35; with \$20 to the Guide  
7 Dogs of America Fund and \$15 to the Secretary of State  
8 Special License Plate Fund.

9 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 going to the Guide Dogs  
10 of America Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of State  
11 Special License Plate Fund.

12 (8) Local Lodge 701 of the International Association  
13 of Machinists and Aerospace Workers.

14 (A) Original issuance: \$35; with \$10 to the Guide  
15 Dogs of America Fund, \$10 to the Mechanics Training  
16 Fund, and \$15 to the Secretary of State Special  
17 License Plate Fund.

18 (B) Renewal: \$30; with \$13 to the Guide Dogs of  
19 America Fund, \$15 to the Mechanics Training Fund, and  
20 \$2 to the Secretary of State Special License Plate  
21 Fund.

22 (9) Illinois Department of Human Services.

23 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the  
24 Theresa Tracy Trot - Illinois CancerCare Foundation  
25 Fund and \$15 to the Secretary of State Special License  
26 Plate Fund.

1 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Theresa Tracy  
2 Trot - Illinois CancerCare Foundation Fund and \$2 to  
3 the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

4 (10) The Illinois Department of Human Services for  
5 developmental disabilities awareness decals.

6 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the  
7 Developmental Disabilities Awareness Fund and \$15 to  
8 the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

9 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Developmental  
10 Disabilities Awareness Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of  
11 State Special License Plate Fund.

12 (11) The Illinois Department of Human Services for  
13 pediatric cancer awareness decals.

14 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the  
15 Pediatric Cancer Awareness Fund and \$15 to the  
16 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

17 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Pediatric Cancer  
18 Awareness Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of State  
19 Special License Plate Fund.

20 (12) The Department of Veterans' Affairs for Fold of  
21 Honor decals.

22 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the Folds  
23 of Honor Foundation Fund and \$15 to the Secretary of  
24 State Special License Plate Fund.

25 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Folds of Honor  
26 Foundation Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of State

1 Special License Plate Fund.

2 (13) ~~(12)~~ The Illinois chapters of the Experimental  
3 Aircraft Association for aviation enthusiast decals.

4 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the  
5 Experimental Aircraft Association Fund and \$15 to the  
6 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

7 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Experimental  
8 Aircraft Association Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of  
9 State Special License Plate Fund.

10 (14) ~~(12)~~ The Illinois Department of Human Services  
11 for Child Abuse Council of the Quad Cities decals.

12 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the Child  
13 Abuse Council of the Quad Cities Fund and \$15 to the  
14 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

15 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Child Abuse  
16 Council of the Quad Cities Fund and \$2 to the Secretary  
17 of State Special License Plate Fund.

20 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the  
21 Illinois Health Care Workers Benefit Fund, and \$15 to

23 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Illinois Health  
24 Care Workers Benefit Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of  
25 State Special License Plate Fund.

26 (16) The Department of Agriculture for Future Farmers

8 (f) The following funds are created as special funds in  
9 the State treasury:

10 (1) The Roadside Monarch Habitat Fund. All money in  
11 the Roadside Monarch Habitat Fund shall be paid as grants  
12 to the Illinois Department of Natural Resources to fund  
13 roadside monarch and other pollinator habitat development,  
14 enhancement, and restoration projects in this State.

15 (2) The Prostate Cancer Awareness Fund. All money in  
16 the Prostate Cancer Awareness Fund shall be paid as grants  
17 to the Prostate Cancer Foundation of Chicago.

18 (3) The Horsemen's Council of Illinois Fund. All money  
19 in the Horsemen's Council of Illinois Fund shall be paid  
20 as grants to the Horsemen's Council of Illinois.

21 (4) The Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Awareness Fund.  
22 All money in the Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Awareness  
23 Fund shall be paid as grants to K9s for Veterans, NFP for  
24 support, education, and awareness of veterans with  
25 post-traumatic stress disorder.

26 (5) The Guide Dogs of America Fund. All money in the

1 Guide Dogs of America Fund shall be paid as grants to the  
2 International Guiding Eyes, Inc., doing business as Guide  
3 Dogs of America.

4 (6) The Mechanics Training Fund. All money in the  
5 Mechanics Training Fund shall be paid as grants to the  
6 Mechanics Local 701 Training Fund.

7 (7) The Theresa Tracy Trot - Illinois CancerCare  
8 Foundation Fund. All money in the Theresa Tracy Trot -  
9 Illinois CancerCare Foundation Fund shall be paid to the  
10 Illinois CancerCare Foundation for the purpose of  
11 furthering pancreatic cancer research.

12 (8) The Developmental Disabilities Awareness Fund. All  
13 money in the Developmental Disabilities Awareness Fund  
14 shall be paid as grants to the Illinois Department of  
15 Human Services to fund legal aid groups to assist with  
16 guardianship fees for private citizens willing to become  
17 guardians for individuals with developmental disabilities  
18 but who are unable to pay the legal fees associated with  
19 becoming a guardian.

20 (9) The Pediatric Cancer Awareness Fund. All money in  
21 the Pediatric Cancer Awareness Fund shall be paid as  
22 grants to the Cancer Center at Illinois for pediatric  
23 cancer treatment and research.

24 (10) The Folds of Honor Foundation Fund. All money in  
25 the Folds of Honor Foundation Fund shall be paid as grants  
26 to the Folds of Honor Foundation to aid in providing

1 educational scholarships to military families.

2 (11) ~~(10)~~ The Experimental Aircraft Association Fund.  
3 All money in the Experimental Aircraft Association Fund  
4 shall be paid, subject to appropriation by the General  
5 Assembly and distribution by the Secretary, as grants to  
6 promote recreational aviation.

7 (12) ~~(10)~~ The Child Abuse Council of the Quad Cities  
8 Fund. All money in the Child Abuse Council of the Quad  
9 Cities Fund shall be paid as grants to benefit the Child  
10 Abuse Council of the Quad Cities.

11 (13) ~~(10)~~ The Illinois Health Care Workers Benefit  
12 Fund. All money in the Illinois Health Care Workers  
13 Benefit Fund shall be paid as grants to the Trinity Health  
14 Foundation for the benefit of health care workers,  
15 doctors, nurses, and others who work in the health care  
16 industry in this State.

17 (14) The Future Farmers of America Fund. All money in  
18 the Future Farmers of America Fund shall be paid as grants  
19 to the Illinois Association of Future Farmers of America.
