#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$5,000,000 to the Department of Public Health to provide health care professionals in Cook County with COVID-19-related resources, including, but not limited to, vaccinations, at-home testing, contact tracing, and educational campaigns. Effective July 1, 2022.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The amount of \$5,000,000, or so much of that  
5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department  
6 of Public Health to provide health care professionals,  
7 including, but not limited to, visiting home nurses, community  
8 health care workers, certified nursing assistants, and  
9 physician assistants, in Cook County with COVID-19-related  
10 resources, including, but not limited to, vaccinations, at-  
11 home testing, contact tracing, and educational campaigns.

12 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
13 2022.
