SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

15 ILCS 205/6.7 new

Amends the Attorney General Act. Creates within the Office of the Attorney General an Independent Investigative Unit for the purpose of investigating all alleged or potential police-involved deaths of civilians. Provides that the Independent Investigative Unit may also investigate any other crimes related to police misconduct that are discovered during an investigation, and may act with the full powers, rights, privileges, and duties of a State's Attorney. Requires the Independent Investigative Unit to transmit a report containing detailed investigative findings to the State's Attorney of the county that has jurisdiction to prosecute the matter. Requires law enforcement agencies to notify the Independent Investigative Unit of any alleged or potential police-involved death of a civilian as soon as the law enforcement agency becomes aware of the incident. Defines "law enforcement agency".

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Attorney General Act is amended by adding
Section 6.7 as follows:

7 <u>Sec. 6.7. Independent Investigative Unit for</u>
8 <u>Police-involved Deaths.</u>

9 (a) There is created within the Office of the Attorney General an Independent Investigative Unit for the purpose of 10 investigating all alleged or potential police-involved deaths 11 of civilians. The Independent Investigative Unit may also 12 investigate any other crimes related to police misconduct that 13 14 are discovered during an investigation under this Section, and may act with the full powers, rights, privileges, and duties 15 16 of a State's Attorney, including the use of a grand jury in any 17 county.

18 (b) Within 15 days after completing an investigation under 19 this Section, the Independent Investigative Unit shall 20 transmit a report containing detailed investigative findings 21 to the State's Attorney of the county that has jurisdiction to 22 prosecute the matter. associated criminal case at the trial court level. 1 (c) To investigate and assist with the investigation of 2 3 alleged criminal offenses committed by police officers, the Independent Investigative Unit may: (i) detail one or more 4 5 police officers employed by the Illinois State Police; and (ii) employ other civilian personnel as needed. 6 (d) For purposes of investigations conducted under this 7

8 Section, a law enforcement agency shall cooperate with the 9 Independent Investigative Unit in connection with the 10 investigation of a police-involved death of a civilian, and 11 shall notify the Independent Investigative Unit of any alleged 12 or potential police-involved death of a civilian as soon as the law enforcement agency becomes aware of the incident. 13

14 (e) For purposes of this Section, "law enforcement agency" 15 means an agency of this State or unit of local government which 16 is vested by law or ordinance with the duty to maintain public order and to enforce criminal laws or ordinances. 17
