1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 5577

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 5577 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section  
5 24-8.2 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/24-8.2 new)

7 Sec. 24-8.2. Minimum salary for certain employees.

8 (a) In this Section, "employee" means any employee of the  
9 school district who provides educational support services to  
10 the district, including, but not limited to, custodial  
11 employees, transportation employees, food service providers,  
12 classroom assistants, administrative staff, or  
13 paraprofessional educators as defined in subparagraph (J) of  
14 paragraph (2) of Section 21B-20.

15 (b) In fixing salaries of employees, school boards shall  
16 pay to employees an hourly rate not less than the following:

1 (i) \$20 for the 2022-2023 school year; (ii) \$21 for the  
2 2023-2024 school year; and (iii) \$22 for the 2024-2025 school  
3 year. The minimum hourly rate for each school year thereafter  
4 shall equal the minimum salary rate for the previous school  
5 year increased by a percentage equal to the percentage  
6 increase, if any, in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban  
7 Consumers for all items published by the United States  
8 Department of Labor for the previous school year.

9 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
10 becoming law.".
