1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated for the
7 ordinary and contingent expenses to the Illinois Commerce
8 Commission:

9 Section 10. The sum of \$600,000, or so much thereof as may
10 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Underground
11 Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois
12 Commerce Commission for a grant to the Statewide One-call
13 Notice System, as required in the Illinois Underground Utility
14 Facilities Damage Prevention Act.

15 Section 15. The sum of \$1,000, or so much thereof as may
16 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Underground
17 Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois
18 Commerce Commission for refunds.

19 Section 20. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
20 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the
21 Transportation Regulatory Fund for ordinary and contingent
22 expenses to the Illinois Commerce Commission:

17 Section 25. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as
 18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation
 19 Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for (1)
 20 disbursing funds collected for the Single State Insurance
 21 Registration Program and/or Unified Carrier Registration
 22 System; (2) for refunds for overpayments; and (3) for
 23 administrative expenses.

1 Section 30. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois
3 Telecommunications Access Corporation Fund to the Illinois
4 Commerce Commission for administrative costs and for
5 distribution to the Illinois Telecommunications Access
6 Corporation, as required in the Illinois Public Utilities Act,
7 Section 13-703.

8 Section 35. The sum of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Public Utility Fund
10 to the Illinois Commerce Commission for all costs associated
11 with the administration of the Energy Transition Act.

12 Section 40. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as
13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Consumer Intervenor
14 Compensation Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for all
15 costs and expenses associated with the administration of the
16 Consumer Intervenor Compensation Fund, and amendments to
17 Section 9-229 of the Illinois Public Utilities Act resulting
18 from enactment of Illinois Public Act 102-0662.

19 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1,
20 2022.
