A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes
7 hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the ordinary and
8 contingent expenses of the Law Enforcement Training Standards
9 Board:

22 Section 10. The following named amount, or so much thereof
23 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes
24 hereinafter named, is appropriated to the Law Enforcement

1 Training Standards Board as follows:

2 GRANTS-IN-AID

3 Payable from the Traffic and Criminal

4 Conviction Surcharge Fund:

5 For payment of and/or reimbursement

6 of basic training and basic training services

7 in accordance with statutory provisions10,290,000

8 For payment of and/or reimbursement

9 of in-service training and in-service training services

10 in accordance with statutory provisions17,220,000

11 Section 15. The amount of \$8,400,000, or so much thereof
12 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
13 Fund to the Law Enforcement Training Standards Board for
14 deposit into the Traffic and Criminal Conviction Surcharge
15 Fund. No portion of this appropriation shall be deposited into
16 the Traffic and Criminal Conviction Surcharge Fund unless and
17 until it is approved in writing by the Governor.

18 Section 20. The sum of \$8,000,000, or so much thereof as
19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Law Enforcement
20 Officers Training Board Federal Projects Fund to the Law
21 Enforcement Training Standards Board for expenses relating to
22 various federal projects

1 Section 25. The amount of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof
2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
3 Fund to the Law Enforcement Training Standards Board for
4 deposit into the Law Enforcement Camera Grant Fund.

5 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1,
6 2022.
