SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations to the Supreme Court for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the judicial system. Effective July 1, 2022.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. In addition to other sums appropriated, the sum
5 of \$489,716,800, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
6 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Supreme Court
7 for operational expenses, awards, grants, permanent
8 improvements, and probation reimbursements for the fiscal year
9 ending June 30, 2023.

10 Section 10. The sum of \$29,131,200, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Mandatory
12 Arbitration Fund to the Supreme Court for Mandatory Arbitration
13 Programs.

14 Section 15. The sum of \$708,800, or so much thereof as may
15 be necessary, is appropriated from the Foreign Language
16 Interpreter Fund to the Supreme Court for the Foreign Language
17 Interpreter Program.

18 Section 20. The sum of \$13,793,900, or so much thereof as
19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Supreme Court
20 Special Purposes Fund to the Supreme Court for the oversight

1 and management of electronic filing, case management systems,
2 and committees and commissions of the Supreme Court.

3 Section 25. The sum of \$4,000,000, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Supreme Court
5 Federal Projects Fund to the Supreme Court for expenses
6 relating to various federal projects.

7 Section 30. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof may
8 be necessary, is appropriated from the Supreme Court Special
9 State Projects Fund to the Supreme Court for expenses relating
10 to various State projects.

11 Section 35. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Cannabis Expungement
13 Fund to the Supreme Court for the distribution to clerks of the
14 circuit court for the facilitation of petitions of expungement
15 of minor cannabis offenses pursuant to the Cannabis Regulation
16 and Tax Act.

17 Section 40. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Mandatory
19 Arbitration Fund to the Supreme Court for reduction of case
20 backlogs and managing increases in case filings, modernizing
21 court technology infrastructure, and Supporting Access to

1 Justice Programs.

2 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
3 2022.
