A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$29,500,000, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Build Illinois Bond
6 Fund to the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for
7 a grant to mHub for infrastructure improvements, including, but
8 not limited to, the construction and renovation of research
9 centers, statewide workforce training facilities, and electric
10 vehicle infrastructure for the purposes of cleantech economy
11 innovation and increased opportunity in underserved and coal-
12 impacted communities.

13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
14 2022.
