

## 102ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2021 and 2022 HB5778

Introduced 11/16/2022, by Rep. Kambium Buckner

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

10 ILCS 5/29-9

from Ch. 46, par. 29-9

Amends the Election Code. Provides that a person is not prohibited from photographing his or her own ballot at any time during the voting process or from viewing a photograph of a completed or partially completed ballot. Provides that any person who gives, promises to give, or receives any money or other valuable consideration in connection with the dissemination or viewing of a photograph of a completed or partially completed ballot is guilty of a Class 4 felony. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing Section 29-9 as follows:
- 6 (10 ILCS 5/29-9) (from Ch. 46, par. 29-9)
- Sec. 29-9. Unlawful observation of voting; photographs of ballots.
- 9 (a) Except as permitted by this Code, any person who knowingly marks his ballot or casts his vote on a voting 10 machine or voting device so that it can be observed by another 11 person, and any person who knowingly observes another person 12 lawfully marking a ballot or lawfully casting his vote on a 13 14 voting machine or voting device, shall be guilty of a Class 4 felony. Nothing in this subsection prohibits a person from 15 16 photographing his or her own ballot at any time during the 17 voting process or from viewing a photograph of a completed or partially completed ballot. 18
- 19 (b) Any person who gives, promises to give, or receives
  20 any money or other valuable consideration in connection with
  21 the dissemination or viewing of a photograph of a completed or
  22 partially completed ballot shall be guilty of a Class 4
  23 felony.
