SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

ILCON Art. III, Sec. 2 rep.

Proposes to amend the Suffrage and Elections Article of the Illinois Constitution. Repeals language denying a person convicted of a felony, or otherwise under sentence in a correctional institution or jail, the right to vote until completion of his or her sentence. Effective upon being declared adopted.

11	SUFFRAGE AND ELECTIONS

13	SECTION 2. VOTING DISQUALIFICATIONS (REPEALED)
14	A person convicted of a felony, or otherwise under
15	sentence in a correctional institution or jail, shall lose the
16	right to vote, which right shall be restored not later than
17	upon completion of his sentence.
