1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of 3 Representatives are saddened to learn of the death of Kenneth

4 R. "Coach" Geiger of Hillside, who passed away on January 21,

5 2021; and

WHEREAS, Ken Geiger was born in Berwyn on December 30, 1931; he was a lifelong resident of Berwyn; he attended St. Leonard School in Berwyn; he graduated from Fenwick High School in Oak Park in 1949, where he played football and boxed for three years; he earned his Bachelor of Science from Monmouth College, where he was an all-conference guard and helped the football team to conference championships during his junior and senior years; he served in the 101st Airborne Division of the U.S. Army in Korea; he obtained his master's degree from the University of Illinois; he earned his doctorate in Education from the University of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, Ken Geiger coached football while earning his master's and doctoral degrees; he was the freshman football offensive line coach at the University of Illinois; he served as the assistant varsity line coach at the University of Missouri; he returned to Monmouth College as the varsity line coach and led the football team to an undefeated conference championship; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Ken Geiger had a 34-year career in the J.
  2 Sterling Morton High School District, where he served as a
  3 teacher, the head football coach, a wrestling coach, the
  4 athletic director, and a department chair; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Ken Geiger entered professional football in the 6 1980s; he served as a scout for the Chicago Bears for 11 years, 7 and he was with the team when they won Super Bowl XX in 1986; 8 he later worked as a scout for the Indianapolis Colts for five 9 years and the New Orleans Saints for three 10 internationally, he was a moving force in bringing American 11 football to Europe, where he taught football to European youths and represented the NFL as a clinician; and 12
  - WHEREAS, Ken Geiger was named to the Monmouth College Hall of Fame in 1996; he was also named to the IHSA Hall of Fame; he was an emeritus member of the American Association of Football Coaches; he was a member of the Chicago Catholic League's Hall of Fame; his family was named the Monmouth College Family of the Year in 2011; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Ken Geiger was known for being a father figure to
  20 his students and one of the foremost ambassadors of Morton
  21 High School; he will be remembered for the impact he made on
  22 the lives of his students; and

WHEREAS, Ken Geiger was the husband of Sheryl J. (Johnson) for 67 years; the father of Gary (Ana Maria), Kevin (Jeane Gentile), Joni (James) Russo, Susan, and Eric (Amy); the son of the late Joseph J. and the late Ann M. (Zaher) Geiger; the grandfather of Joseph Bratta, Sean Geiger, and Niko Muniz; the great-grandfather to Mia Rose, Joseph, and Layla Bratta; the brother of the late Joseph (Nancy) Geiger; the brother-in-law of Celinda (Bob) Prater; and the uncle and great-uncle to many; therefore, be it
