WHEREAS, The son of a six-term state representative, Don Jacobs had a long political career; he served as a precinct committeeman, an East Moline alderman for nine years, a Rock Island County auditor for 21 years, and a Rock Island County finance chairman; he retired from Rock Island County at age 85; uniquely suited for public service, he knew how to run a business, understood the workings of politics, and could relate to and work with all, no matter the political party; and
