2 WHEREAS, The Illinois Migrant Council, in partnership with 3 Community Health Partnership and First Street Renaissance, has 4 been holding pop up vaccine clinics throughout the State 5 through the Equity Distribution Division of the Illinois 6 Department of Public Health; and

WHEREAS, The Illinois Migrant Council clinics are unique and provide a friendly, family-oriented atmosphere; many attendees come with their children or in multi-generational families and share their gratitude, relief, and joy after receiving their shots; and

WHEREAS, The Illinois Migrant Council team provides the dignity, compassion, and cultural competence that leads to people feeling safe, valued, and respected, and is making a difference with heroic leadership in the fight to get everyone in our great State vaccinated; and
