WHEREAS, Malik Alim joined the staff of the Chicago Community Bond Fund (CCBF) in December of 2019 and quickly became a champion for the movement to end money bond in Illinois; he worked as CCBF's advocate and represented the organization in many campaigns, such as the Budget for Black Lives; his previous role at CCBF was as the campaign coordinator for the Coalition to End Money Bond, and he played an instrumental role in the passage of the Pretrial Fairness Act, which allows individuals to be released prior to trial without posting cash bond unless charged with specific offenses or deemed a danger; and
