2           WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of  
3 Representatives wish to commend Village of Lake Bluff  
4 President Kathleen O'Hara for her lifetime of public service;

6           WHEREAS, President O'Hara was born in Charlotte, North  
7 Carolina, but moved to Lincolnshire when she was 17; she  
8 received her Bachelor of Science in History from Illinois  
9 State University, where she studied history and political  
10 science; she earned her Master of Science in Educational  
11 Leadership and Administration from Northern Illinois  
12 University; and

13           WHEREAS, President O'Hara taught Social Studies to the  
14 youth of Lake Bluff Middle School for 19 years; she then served  
15 as the principal of Lake Bluff Middle School for an additional  
16 17 years before retiring in 2005; and

17           WHEREAS, President O'Hara continued to serve her community  
18 as a Village of Lake Bluff Trustee from 2007 to 2013; she then  
19 served as Village of Lake Bluff President from 2013 to 2021;

21           WHEREAS, President O'Hara further serves her community as

1 co-founder of the Lake Bluff History Museum and as a member of  
2 the Lake Bluff School Caucus; and

3 WHEREAS, President O'Hara has always prioritized  
4 preserving the local history of the Lake Bluff community and  
5 has co-authored two books on Lake Bluff; and

6 WHEREAS, President O'Hara mentored many local elected  
7 officials and oversaw a period of improvements to the  
8 infrastructure, beautification, and public safety of the  
9 Village of Lake Bluff; therefore, be it

10 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE  
11 HUNDRED SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that  
12 we commend Village of Lake Bluff President Kathleen O'Hara for
