1 HOUSE RESOLUTION 743

- 2 WHEREAS, The Vietnam War was fought in Vietnam from 1961 3 to 1975 and involved North Vietnam and the Viet Cong in 4 conflict with the United States Armed Forces and South 5 Vietnam; and
- WHEREAS, The United States became involved by serving in an advisory role to the South Vietnamese in 1961; and
- 8 WHEREAS, In 1965, United States Armed Forces ground combat 9 units arrived in Vietnam, and by the end of that year, there 10 were 80,000 United States troops in Vietnam with a peak of 11 approximately 500,000 troops in 1969; and
- 12 WHEREAS, On January 27, 1973, the Treaty of Paris was
 13 signed, which required the release of all United States
 14 prisoners-of-war held in North Vietnam and the withdrawal of
 15 all United States Armed Forces from South Vietnam; by March
 16 30, 1973, the United States Armed Forces completed the
 17 withdrawal of combat troops from Vietnam; and
- WHEREAS, More than 58,000 members of the United States

 Armed Forces lost their lives in Vietnam, and more than

 300,000 members of the Armed Forces were wounded; and

- WHEREAS, In 1982, the Vietnam Veterans Memorial was 1
- 2 dedicated in Washington, D.C. to commemorate those members of
- the United States Armed Forces who died or were declared 3
- missing-in-action in Vietnam; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Members of the United States Armed Forces who
- 6 served bravely and faithfully for the United States during the
- 7 Vietnam War were caught upon their return home in the
- crossfire of public debate about the involvement of the United 8
- 9 States in the Vietnam War; and
- 10 WHEREAS, March 29th marks the anniversary of the day that
- 11 combat and combat support units withdrew completely from South
- 12 Vietnam; and
- 13 WHEREAS, On March 7, 2011, the 112th U.S. Congress agreed
- 14 to Senate Resolution 55, honoring veterans who served in
- Vietnam by designating March 30th as "Welcome Home Vietnam" 15
- Veterans Day"; and 16
- WHEREAS, The establishment of a "Welcome Home Vietnam" 17
- 18 Veterans Day" is an appropriate way to honor those members of
- the United States Armed Forces who served in Vietnam during 19
- 20 the Vietnam War; therefore, be it
- 21 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE

- 1 HUNDRED SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
- 2 we declare March 29, 2022 as "Welcome Home Vietnam Veterans
- 3 Day" in the State of Illinois; and be it further
- 4 RESOLVED, That all citizens of the State of Illinois are
- 5 encouraged to honor our Vietnam veterans.
