1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 100

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 100 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
5 changing Section 5-2.07 as follows:

6 (305 ILCS 5/5-2.07)

7 Sec. 5-2.07. Use of Medicaid spend-down. No later than
8 July 1, 2007, subject to federal approval of a State Medicaid
9 Plan amendment, which shall be sought by the Department of
10 Healthcare and Family Services or its successor agency,
11 persons described in item 2(a) of Section 5-2, who fail to
12 qualify for basic maintenance under Article III of this Code
13 on the basis of need because of excess income or assets, or
14 both, may establish eligibility for medical assistance by
15 paying the amount of their monthly spend-down under this
16 Article (as described in 42 CFR 435.831) to the Department of

1 Healthcare and Family Services or its successor agency or by
2 having a third party pay that amount to the Department on their
3 behalf. A person who uses Medicaid spend-down to qualify for
4 medical assistance shall be provided up to 6 consecutive
5 months to submit and have medical receipts and bills processed
6 by the Department as evidence of payment of the person's
7 monthly spend-down amount before becoming ineligible for
8 medical assistance under this Section.
