SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

220 ILCS 5/9-254 new

Amends the Public Utilities Act. Provides that a public utility providing electric service to less than 800,000 customers may not charge non-residential customers a rate from June through September that is more than 10% higher than the rate charged from October through May. Effective immediately.

- 8 provision of law to the contrary, a public utility providing
- 9 electric service to less than 800,000 customers may not charge
- 10 non-residential customers a rate from June through September
- 11 that is more than 10% higher than the rate charged from October
- 12 through May.
- 13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 14 becoming law.
