

102ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2021 and 2022 SB0221

Introduced 2/17/2021, by Sen. Bill Cunningham

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

210 ILCS 55/2.09

Amends the Home Health, Home Services, and Home Nursing Agency Licensing Act. Provides that "home services" includes assistance with: bathing without client self-direction, including areas of the body other than those areas with special skin care needs; applying topical prescription lotions to rashes, skin tears, stage 1 or 2 decubiti, and first and second degree burns; applying compression stockings; assisting with normal feeding, including pre-measured, thickened liquids; applying shampoo in hair care treatment requiring a prescription; permitting nail filing of clients with conditions that might involve peripheral circulatory conditions; assisting with personal, mechanical, or electronic transfers of clients when the client can assist with transfer; assisting with ambulation of clients using adaptative equipment for ambulation; assisting with changing oxygen tanks, adjusting oxygen flow, and turning oxygen tanks on and off; and repositioning clients every 2 hours or as instructed by the plan of care.

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Home Health, Home Services, and Home

 Nursing Agency Licensing Act is amended by changing Section
- 6 2.09 as follows:

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- 7 (210 ILCS 55/2.09)
- Sec. 2.09. "Home services" or "in-home services" means 8 9 assistance with activities of: daily living; + housekeeping; + personal laundry; bathing without client self-direction, 10 including areas of the body other than those areas with 11 12 special skin care needs; applying topical prescription lotions to rashes, skin tears, stage 1 or 2 decubiti, and first and 13 14 second degree burns; applying compression stockings; assisting with normal feeding, including pre-measured, thickened 15 16 liquids; applying shampoo in hair care treatment requiring a prescription; permitting nail filing of clients with 17 conditions that might involve peripheral circulatory 18 19 conditions; assisting with personal, mechanical, or electronic 20 transfers of clients when the client can assist with transfer; 21 assisting with ambulation of clients using adaptative 22 equipment for ambulation; assisting with changing oxygen

tanks, adjusting oxygen flow, and turning oxygen tanks on and

- off; repositioning clients every 2 hours or as instructed by
- 2 <u>the plan of care;</u> and <u>providing</u> companionship provided to an
- 3 individual in his or her personal residence, which are
- 4 intended to enable that individual to remain safely and
- 5 comfortably in his or her own personal residence. "Home
- 6 services" or "in-home services" does not include services that
- 7 would be required to be performed by an individual licensed
- 8 under the Nurse Practice Act.
