#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Department of Labor for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021, as follows:

General Funds	\$ 7,493,900
Other State Funds	\$ 2,238,500
Federal Funds	\$ 5,400,000
Total	\$15,132,400

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A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
6 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes  
7 hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the ordinary and  
8 contingent expenses of the Department of Labor:

2 Section 10. The amount of \$338,400, or so much thereof as  
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Amusement Ride and  
4 Patron Safety Fund to the Department of Labor for operational  
5 expenses associated with the administration of The Amusement  
6 Ride and Attraction Safety Act.

7 Section 15. The amount of \$650,100, or so much thereof as  
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Child Labor and Day  
9 and Temporary Labor Services Enforcement Fund to the Department  
10 of Labor for operational expenses associated with the  
11 administration of The Child Labor Law Act and the Day and  
12 Temporary Labor Services Act.

13 Section 20. The amount of \$150,000, or so much thereof as  
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Employee  
15 Classification Fund to the Department of Labor for operational  
16 expenses associated with the administration of The Employee  
17 Classification Act.

18 Section 25. The amount of \$100,000, or so much thereof as  
19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wage Theft  
20 Enforcement Fund to the Department of Labor for operational  
21 expenses associated with the administration of The Illinois  
22 Wage Payment and Collection Act.

1           Section 30. The amount of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof  
2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Department of  
3 Labor Federal Trust Fund to the Department of Labor for all  
4 costs associated with promoting and enforcing the occupational  
5 safety and health administration state program for public  
6 sector worksites.

7           Section 35. The amount of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof  
8 as necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Industrial  
9 Services Fund to the Department of Labor for administrative and  
10 other expenses and for the Occupational Safety and Health  
11 Administration Program, including refunds and prior year costs.

12           Section 40. The amount of \$400,000, or so much thereof as  
13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Department of Labor  
14 Federal Indirect Cost Fund to the Department of Labor for all  
15 costs associated with OSHA Indirect Costs.

16           Section 45. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as  
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Equal Pay  
18 Registration Fund to the Department of Labor for all costs  
19 associated with the administration of the Equal Pay Act of  
20 2003.

1           Section 50. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as may  
2           be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to  
3           the Department of Labor for all costs associated with the  
4           administration of the Equal Pay Act of 2003.

5           Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
6           2021.
