A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The amount of \$23,217,200, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
7 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education to meet its
8 operational expenses for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
9 2021.

10 Section 5. The following amounts, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois State Board
12 of Education for Evidence-Based Funding, provided for in
13 Section 18-8.15 of the School Code:

14	Payable from the Education Assistance Fund.....	328,529,000
15	Payable from the Common School Fund.....	3,029,136,300
16	Payable from the General Revenue Fund.....	3,081,372,927
17	Payable from the Fund for the Advancement	
18	of Education.....	790,000,000

19 It is the intent of the General Assembly to provide
20 sufficient appropriations in this section to ensure that only

1 the Base Funding Minimum amount, and no more, is distributed
 2 to Organizational and Specially Funded Units in Fiscal Year
 3 2022, plus additional amounts for English Learner Professional
 4 Development activities and customary and ordinary adjustments.

5 Section 10. The following amounts, or so much thereof as
 6 may be necessary, which shall be used by the Illinois State
 7 Board of Education exclusively for the foregoing purposes and
 8 not, under any circumstances, for personal services
 9 expenditures or other operational or administrative costs, are
 10 appropriated to the Illinois State Board of Education for the

 12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
 13 to the Illinois State Board of Education for all costs
 14 associated with Educator Misconduct Hearings and
 15 Investigations.

16 Section 35. The amount of \$6,000,000, or so much thereof
 17 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 18 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for the Social-
 19 Emotional Learning and Trauma Response Program for a grant to
 20 the following named entities, at the approximate costs below:

7 ARTICLE 2

8 Section 5. The amount of \$6,000,000, or so much thereof
 9 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Teacher
 10 Certificate Fee Revolving Fund to the Illinois State Board of
 11 Education for all costs authorized by the Educator Licensure
 12 Article of the School Code, including refunds.

13 Section 10. The amount of \$8,484,800, or so much thereof
 14 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Board of
 15 Education Special Purpose Trust Fund to the Illinois State
 16 Board of Education for expenditures by the Board in accordance
 17 with grants, gifts or donations that the Board has received or
 18 may receive from any source, public or private, in support of
 19 projects that are within the lawful powers of the Board,
 20 including refunds.

21 Section 15. The amount of \$8,150,000, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Board of
2 Education Special Purpose Trust Fund to the Illinois State
3 Board of Education for its ordinary and contingent expenses.

4 Section 20. The amount of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the School District
6 Emergency Financial Assistance Fund for use by the Illinois
7 State Board of Education as provided in Section 1B-8 of the
8 School Code.

9 Section 25. The amount of \$2,208,900, or so much thereof
10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the ISBE Teacher
11 Certificate Institute Fund to the Illinois State Board of
12 Education for costs authorized by the School Code, including
13 refunds.

14 Section 30. The amount of \$200,000, or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the After-School Rescue
16 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for its ordinary
17 and contingent expenses.

18 Section 35. The amount of \$600,000, or so much thereof as
19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the School
20 Infrastructure Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education
21 for its ordinary and contingent expenses.

1 Section 40. The amount of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof
 2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Temporary
 3 Relocation Expenses Revolving Grant Fund for use by the
 4 Illinois State Board of Education as provided in Section 2-
 5 3.77 of the School Code.

6 Section 45. The amount of \$1,050,000, or so much thereof
 7 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Board of
 8 Education Special Purpose Trust Fund to the Illinois State
 9 Board of Education for all costs associated with its Charter
 10 School Department per 105 ILCS 5/27A-7.5.

11 Section 50. The amount of \$11,400,000, or so much thereof
 12 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Personal Property
 13 Tax Replacement Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education
 14 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021 for Regional
 15 Superintendents' and Assistants' Compensation and Related
 16 Benefits.

17 Section 55. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
 18 as may be necessary, are appropriated from the Personal

 20 Department of Education Fund to the Illinois State Board of
 21 Education for grants, contracts, and administrative expenses
 22 of the Governor's Emergency Education Relief Fund per the
 23 Coronavirus, Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act.

1 Section 50. The amount of \$2,250,805,000, or so much
2 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the SBE
3 Federal Department of Education Fund to the Illinois State
4 Board of Education for grants, contracts, and administrative
5 expenses of the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency
6 Relief Fund per the Coronavirus Response and Relief
7 Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021.

8 Section 55. The amount of \$132,400,000, or so much thereof
9 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the SBE Federal
10 Department of Education Fund to the Illinois State Board of
11 Education for grants, contracts, and administrative expenses
12 of the Governor's Emergency Education Relief Fund per the
13 Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations
14 Act, 2021.

15 ARTICLE 4

16 Section 1. The sum of \$5,693,706,973, or so much thereof
17 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Common School
18 Fund to the Teachers' Retirement System of the State of Illinois
19 for the State's contribution, as provided by law.

20 Section 5. The sum of \$400,000, or so much thereof as may

1 be necessary, is appropriated from the Education Assistance
2 Fund to the Teachers' Retirement System of the State of Illinois
3 for additional costs due to the establishment of minimum
4 retirement allowances pursuant to Sections 16-136.2 and 16-
5 136.3 of the Illinois Pension Code.

6 Section 10. The sum of \$375,000, or so much thereof as may
7 be necessary, is appropriated from the Common School Fund to
8 the Teachers' Retirement System of the State of Illinois for
9 the employer contributions required by the State as an employer
10 of teachers described under subsection (e) or subsection (f)
11 of Section 16-158 of the Illinois Pension Code.

12 Section 15. The amount of \$143,369,061, or so much thereof
13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
14 Fund to the Teachers' Retirement System of the State of Illinois
15 for deposit into the Teacher Health Insurance Security Fund as
16 the State's contribution for teachers' health insurance.

17 Section 20. The amount of \$12,649,000, or so much thereof
18 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Common School
19 Fund to the Public School Teachers' Pension and Retirement Fund
20 of Chicago for the State's contribution pursuant to subsection
21 (c) of Section 17-127 of the Illinois Pension Code.

1 Section 25. The amount of \$264,848,000, or so much thereof
2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Common School
3 Fund to the Public School Teachers' Pension and Retirement Fund
4 of Chicago for the State's contribution pursuant to paragraph
5 (2) of subsection (d) of Section 17-127 of the Illinois Pension
6 Code.

8 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
9 1, 2021.
