1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 633 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend Senate Bill 633 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The Department of State Police Law of the 4 5 Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by adding 6 Section 2605-615 as follows: 7 (20 ILCS 2605/2605-615 new) Sec. 2605-615. Sexual assault data. The Illinois State 8 Police shall post on its website for each school year the total 9 10 number of sexual assault incidents reported by school districts statewide and in each school district under Sections 11 10-20.75 and 34-18.67 of the School Code. The Illinois State 12 13 Police shall also report the data annually to the General Assembly no later than September 1 of each year. 14

Section 10. The School Code is amended by adding Sections
