SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

110 ILCS 330/6.8 new
210 ILCS 85/7.7 new

Amends the University of Illinois Hospital Act and Hospital Licensing Act. Provides that a hospital shall maintain a metal detector at each point of entry into the hospital. Provides that a hospital shall ensure that all members of the public, other than the employees of the hospital who display proper credentials, who enter the hospital at a point of entry are subjected to screening by a metal detector. Provides that individuals subject to screening shall include, but not be limited to, individuals in wheelchairs. Defines "point of entry". Effective July 1, 2021.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The University of Illinois Hospital Act is
5 amended by adding Section 6.8 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 330/6.8 new)

7 Sec. 6.8. Metal detectors required. As used in this
8 Section, "point of entry" means an entrance accessible to the
9 public. "Point of entry" does not include ambulance entrances.

10 The University of Illinois Hospital shall maintain a metal
11 detector at each point of entry into the University of
12 Illinois Hospital. The University of Illinois Hospital shall
13 ensure that all members of the public, other than the
14 employees of the University of Illinois Hospital who display
15 proper credentials, who enter the University of Illinois
16 Hospital at a point of entry are subjected to screening by a
17 metal detector. Individuals subject to screening under this
18 Section shall include, but not be limited to, individuals in
19 wheelchairs.

20 Section 10. The Hospital Licensing Act is amended by
21 adding Section 7.7 as follows:

1 (210 ILCS 85/7.7 new)

2 Sec. 7.7. Metal detectors required. As used in this
3 Section, "point of entry" means an entrance accessible to the
4 public. "Point of entry" does not include ambulance entrances.

5 A hospital licensed under this Act shall maintain a metal
6 detector at each point of entry into the hospital. A hospital
7 shall ensure that all members of the public, other than the
8 employees of the hospital who display proper credentials, who
9 enter the hospital at a point of entry are subjected to
10 screening by a metal detector. Individuals subject to
11 screening under this Section shall include, but not be limited
12 to, individuals in wheelchairs.

13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
14 2021.
