1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1234

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 1234 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding
5 Section 13C-80 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/13C-80 new)

7 Sec. 13C-80. Inspection replacement plan; report to
8 General Assembly. By October 1, 2022, the Agency shall submit
9 a written report to the General Assembly containing its plan
10 to replace the dismantled official inspection stations located
11 in the City of Chicago. The removal of the official inspection
12 stations adversely impacted Chicago's 2.8 million population.

13 The plan shall consist of either a pilot program or a
14 permanent replacement program. The described plan shall
15 provide information on the proposed locations of the new
16 stations within the City of Chicago, information on programs

1 implemented in other states, and a target date for full
2 operation of all stations. The Agency shall issue a request
3 for proposals related to its plan by January 1, 2023.

4 The described plan shall also contain a timeline of
5 actions including the issuance of a request for proposals by
6 January 1, 2023. The plan shall include procurement of
7 services, technology, equipment, and other elements necessary
8 to replace the former vehicle testing lanes and shall state
9 whether the replacement stations in the City of Chicago will
10 utilize permanent self-service kiosks or other services. The
11 plan shall also include the Agency's strategy of how best to
12 inform people of the location and hours of operation of the new
13 official inspection stations and conduct an informational
14 campaign.

15 Any contracts awarded as a result of this plan shall
16 adhere to all State procurement requirements. The State shall
17 consider contracting with minority-owned businesses as defined
18 in Section 2 of the Business Enterprise for Minorities, Women,
19 and Persons with Disabilities Act.

20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
21 becoming law."
