1 AN ACT concerning wildlife.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Wildlife Code is amended by changing
Section 2.25 as follows:

6 (520 ILCS 5/2.25) (from Ch. 61, par. 2.25)

7 Sec. 2.25. It shall be unlawful for any person to take deer 8 except (i) with a shotgun, handgun, or muzzleloading rifle or 9 (ii) as provided by administrative rule, with a bow and arrow, during the open season of not more than 14 days which will be 10 11 set annually by the Director between the dates of November 1st and December 31st, both inclusive, or a special 3-day, 12 13 youth-only season between the dates of September 1 and October 14 31. For the purposes of this Section, legal handguns include any centerfire handguns of .30 caliber or larger with a 15 16 minimum barrel length of 4 inches. The only legal ammunition for a centerfire handgun is a cartridge of .30 caliber or 17 larger with a capability of at least 500 foot pounds of energy 18 19 at the muzzle. Full metal jacket bullets may not be used to 20 harvest deer.

The Department shall make administrative rules concerning management restrictions applicable to the firearm and bow and arrow season. SB1245 Engrossed - 2 - LRB102 05055 CMG 15074 b

1 It shall be unlawful for any person to take deer except 2 with a bow and arrow during the open season for bow and arrow 3 set annually by the Director between the dates of September 4 1st and January 31st, both inclusive.

5 It shall be unlawful for any person to take deer except 6 with (i) a muzzleloading rifle or (ii) bow and arrow during the 7 open season for muzzleloading rifles set annually by the 8 Director.

9 The Director shall cause an administrative rule setting 10 forth the prescribed rules and regulations, including bag and 11 possession limits and those counties of the State where open 12 seasons are established, to be published in accordance with 13 Sections 1.3 and 1.13 of this Act.

14 The Department may establish separate harvest periods for 15 the purpose of managing or eradicating disease that has been 16 found in the deer herd. This season shall be restricted to gun 17 or bow and arrow hunting only. The Department shall publicly announce, via statewide news release, the season dates and 18 19 shooting hours, the counties and sites open to hunting, permit requirements, application dates, hunting rules, legal weapons, 20 21 and reporting requirements.

The Department is authorized to establish a separate harvest period at specific sites within the State for the purpose of harvesting surplus deer that cannot be taken during the regular season provided for the taking of deer. and shall be established during the period of September 1st to 1 2 February 15th, both inclusive. The Department shall publicly 3 announce, via statewide news release, the season dates and shooting hours, and the counties and sites open to hunting. 4 5 The Department shall publish suitable prescribed rules and regulations established by administrative rule pertaining to 6 7 management restrictions applicable to this special harvest 8 program. The Department shall allow unused gun deer permits 9 that are left over from a regular season for the taking of deer 10 to be rolled over and used during any separate harvest period 11 held within 6 months of the season for which those tags were 12 issued at no additional cost to the permit holder subject to 13 the management restrictions applicable to the special harvest 14 program.

Beginning July 1, 2019, and on an annual basis thereafter, 15 16 the Department shall provide a report to the General Assembly 17 providing information regarding deer management programs established by the Code or by administrative rule that 18 includes: (1) the number of surplus deer taken during each 19 20 separate harvest season; (2) the number of deer found to have a 21 communicable disease or other abnormality; and (3) what 22 happens to the deer taken during each separate harvest season. 23 (Source: P.A. 101-66, eff. 7-12-19.)
