SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations to the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021. Effective immediately.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The amount of \$80,000,000, or so much of that
5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State
6 Coronavirus Urgent Remediation Emergency Fund to the Department
7 of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for all costs associated
8 with the COVID-19 Small Business Relief Program, including, but
9 not limited to, administration, technical assistance, and the
10 awarding of grants to qualifying businesses that have
11 experienced interruption of business due to forced closure or
12 inability to carry out regular functions in an economically
13 viable manner under the Governor's Restore Illinois plan or
14 other mitigations, or other such purposes eligible for payment
15 from the federal Coronavirus Relief Fund in accordance with
16 Section 5001 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic
17 Security Act ("CARES Act") and any related federal guidance.

18 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
19 becoming law.
