2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 1673 on page 1,
3 line 4, after "by", by inserting "changing Sections 2.11c,
4 3.5, and 9, and by"; and

5 on page 1, by inserting immediately below line 5 the
6 following:

7 "(510 ILCS 5/2.11c)

8 Sec. 2.11c. Intact animal. "Intact animal" means an animal
9 that has not been sterilized ~~spayed or neutered~~.

11 (510 ILCS 5/3.5)

12 Sec. 3.5. County animal population fund use limitation.
13 Funds placed in the county animal population control fund may
14 only be used to (1) ~~spay, neuter,~~ vaccinate, or sterilize
15 adopted dogs or cats; (2) sterilize ~~spay, neuter,~~ or vaccinate

1 dogs or cats owned by low income county residents who are
2 eligible for the Food Stamp Program or Social Security
3 Disability Benefits Program; or (3) sterilize ~~spay, neuter,~~
4 and vaccinate feral cats in programs recognized by the county
5 or a municipality. This Section does not apply to a county with
6 3,000,000 or more inhabitants.

11 "Sec. 3.6. Feral cat jurisdiction and sterilization. The
12 Department and no other State agency has any jurisdiction over
13 feral cats."; and

14 on page 1, by inserting below line 12 the following:

15 "(510 ILCS 5/9) (from Ch. 8, par. 359)

16 Sec. 9. Any dog found running at large contrary to
17 provisions of this Act may be apprehended and impounded. For
18 this purpose, the Administrator shall utilize any existing or
19 available animal control facility or licensed animal shelter.
20 The dog's owner shall pay a \$25 public safety fine to be
21 deposited into the county animal control fund or the county
22 pet population control fund. Funds transferred to or retained
23 by a municipality before the effective date of this amendatory

1 Act of the 100th General Assembly under this paragraph shall
2 continue to be transferred to and be retained by that
3 municipality. A dog found running at large contrary to the
4 provisions of this Act a second or subsequent time must be
5 sterilized ~~spayed or neutered~~ within 30 days after being
6 reclaimed unless already sterilized ~~spayed or neutered~~;
7 failure to comply shall result in impoundment.

8 A dog that is actively engaged in a legal hunting
9 activity, including training, is not considered to be running
10 at large if the dog is on land that is open to hunting or on
11 land on which the person has obtained permission to hunt or to
12 train a dog. A dog that is in a dog-friendly area or dog park
13 is not considered to be running at large if the dog is
14 monitored or supervised by a person.
