1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1767

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 1767 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Prevailing Wage Act is amended by changing
5 Section 5.1 as follows:

6 (820 ILCS 130/5.1)

7 Sec. 5.1. Electronic database. The Department shall
8 develop and maintain an electronic database capable of
9 accepting and retaining certified payrolls submitted under
10 this Act no later than April 1, 2020. The database shall accept
11 certified payroll forms provided by the Department that are
12 fillable and designed to accept electronic signatures.
13 Beginning January 1, 2022, the Department shall make
14 accessible to the public on its website by the 16th day of each
15 month following the month the work was performed the following
16 information from certified payrolls submitted under this Act:

1 each worker's (i) name, (ii) classification or
2 classifications, (iii) skill level, such as apprentice or
3 journeyman, (iv) gross wages paid in each pay period, (v)
4 number of hours worked each day, (vi) starting and ending
5 times of work each day, (vii) hourly wage rate, (viii) hourly
6 overtime wage rate, and (ix) hourly fringe benefit rate. The
7 database shall be searchable by contractor name, project name,
8 county in which the work was performed, and contracting public
9 body.

11 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
12 becoming law."
