1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1789

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 1789 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Department of Healthcare and Family
5 Services Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is
6 amended by adding Sections 2205-35 and 2205-40 as follows:

7 (20 ILCS 2205/2205-35 new)

8 Sec. 2205-35. Generic prescription drug contracting. The
9 Department of Healthcare and Family Services shall implement
10 and develop a program to establish a State prescription
11 generic drug label for the purpose of increasing competition
12 in the generic drug market and lowering generic drug prices
13 for all purchasers. The Department shall contract with one or
14 more generic drug manufacturers to manufacture certain generic
15 drugs on behalf of the State and participating entities. The
16 Department shall adopt rules necessary to implement and

1 administer the program created under this Section.

2 (20 ILCS 2205/2205-40 new)

3 Sec. 2205-40. State Generic Drug Label Task Force.

4 (a) There is hereby established the State Generic Drug
5 Label Task Force to study the cost savings of establishing a
6 State prescription generic drug label.

7 (b) The Task Force shall consist of the following members:

8 (1) one member of the House of Representatives
9 appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives
10 in consultation with the Minority Leader of the House of
11 Representatives;

12 (2) one member of the Senate appointed by the
13 President of the Senate in consultation with the Minority
14 Leader of the Senate;

15 (3) one member who is a representative of the
16 Department of Healthcare and Family Services appointed by
17 the Director of Healthcare and Family Services;

18 (4) one member from a managed care organization
19 appointed by the Director of Healthcare and Family
20 Services; and

21 (5) one member who is a pharmacist appointed by the
22 Director of Healthcare and Family Services.

23 (c) Members of the Task Force shall serve without
24 compensation.

25 (d) The Department shall provide administrative support to

1 the Task Force.

2 (e) The Task Force shall select from among its members of a
3 chairperson. The Task Force shall convene and hold its first
4 meeting beginning in September 2021, and shall hold at least
5 one meeting per month until the issuance of the report of the
6 Task Force under subsection (f).

7 (f) The Task Force shall study the cost savings of
8 establishing a State prescription generic drug label, and all
9 relevant and related matters, and issue a report on its
10 findings to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before
11 December 31, 2021.

12 (g) This Section is repealed on January 1, 2023.

13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
14 becoming law.".
