1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1826

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 1826 on page 7, by

3 inserting immediately below line 4 the following:

4 "Section 20. Reports; evaluations.

(a) In accordance with Section 5-5.24 of the Illinois Public Aid Code, beginning January 1, 2024, and each January 1 thereafter through January 1, 2028, the Department of Healthcare and Family Services shall report to the General Assembly the expenditures associated with the provision of perinatal care services to pilot program participants who are insured under the State's Medical Assistance Program. Specifically, the Department shall report to the General Assembly the incidences of low birthweight, preterm birth, hospital admission for neonatal intensive care services, and severe maternal morbidity, pregnancy-related mortality, and neonatal mortality among program participants. The Department

of Healthcare and Family Services shall collect and maintain

- deidentified demographic data for all program participants.
- 2 Demographic data collected for any program participant shall
- 3 include the participant's zip code of residence at the time of
- 4 program enrollment, parity, maternal race and ethnicity,
- 5 maternal age at delivery, and weeks' gestation at the time of
- 6 program enrollment.
- 7 (b) The Department of Public Health shall monitor and
- 8 evaluate implementation of the alternative health care
- 9 delivery model provided under the pilot program in accordance
- 10 with the relevant terms and standards under Section 20 of the
- 11 Alternative Health Care Delivery Act.".
