Amend Senate Bill 1847, AS AMENDED, 3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No. 4 2, on page 2, line 18, by replacing "If the Executive Inspector General finds that any" with the following: 5 6 "Any Department employee who divulges, except in accordance with a proper judicial order or otherwise provided by law, confidential information received by the 8 Department from any business pursuant to this Act shall be 9 deemed to have violated the State Officials and Employees 10 Ethics Act and be subject to the penalties established 11 12 under subsections (e) and (f) of Section 50-5 of that Act after investigation and opportunity for hearing before the 13 14 Executive Ethics Commission in accordance with Section 20-50 of that Act"; and 15
