#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/12-4.54 new

Amends the Illinois Public Aid Code. Requires the Department of Healthcare and Family Services to apply for all available federal funding to promote community inclusion and integration for persons with disabilities, regardless of age, and older adults so that those persons have the option to transition out of institutions and receive long-term care services and supports in the settings of their choice. Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by  
5 adding Section 12-4.54 as follows:

6 (305 ILCS 5/12-4.54 new)

7 Sec. 12-4.54. Community-based long-term services;  
8 application for federal funding. The Department of Healthcare  
9 and Family Services shall apply for all available federal  
10 funding to promote community inclusion and integration for  
11 persons with disabilities, regardless of age, and older adults  
12 so that those persons have the option to transition out of  
13 institutions and receive long-term care services and supports  
14 in the settings of their choice.

15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
16 becoming law.
