SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

New Act

Creates the Taxpayer Transparency Act. Provides that a bill making an appropriation may not be considered for final passage by either the House of Representatives or the Senate unless a copy of that bill, in its final form, has been made conveniently available on the General Assembly's Internet website for at least 4 days before final legislative action by the General Assembly prior to presentation to the Governor. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning finance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
- 5 Taxpayer Transparency Act.
- 6 5. Public availability; General Revenue Fund 7 appropriations. A bill making an appropriation from the General Revenue Fund may not be considered for final passage 8 9 by either the House of Representatives or the Senate unless a copy of that bill, in its final form, has been made 10 conveniently available to the public on the General Assembly's 11 Internet website for at least 4 calendar days before final 12 13 legislative action by the General Assembly prior 14 presentation to the Governor. This restriction does not apply to amendments or conference committee reports that make only 15 16 technical or non-substantive changes or to supplemental 17 appropriations.
- 18 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 19 becoming law.
