

## 102ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2021 and 2022 SB2299

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/29-6.3 105 ILCS 5/29-6.3a new 625 ILCS 5/1-148.3a-5 625 ILCS 5/11-1414.1 625 ILCS 5/11-1414.2 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that a multifunction school-activity bus may additionally be used for transportation to a college, university, student job site developed through a partnership with the school, a college or career fair, or an experience that the school determines will contribute to a student's college or career readiness. Provides that, from January 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022, a student in any of grades K through 12 may be transported in a multifunction school-activity bus for any transportation from home to school or from school to home. Amends the School Code to make conforming changes and to provide that a student in any of grades 7 through 12 (instead of grades 9 through 12) may be transported in a multifunction school-activity bus for specified purposes.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section

- Sec. 29-6.3. Transportation to and from specified interscholastic or school-sponsored activities.
- 9 (a) Any school district transporting students in grade 12 or below for an interscholastic, interscholastic athletic, or 10 school-sponsored, noncurriculum-related activity that (i) does 11 not require student participation as part of the educational 12 services of the district and (ii) is not associated with the 13 14 students' regular class-for-credit schedule or required 5 clock hours of instruction under Section 10-19.05 shall 15 transport the students only in a school bus, a vehicle 16 manufactured to transport not more than 10 persons, including 17 driver, or a multifunction school-activity 18 19 manufactured to transport not more than 15 persons, including 20 the driver.
  - (a-5) A student in any of grades 7 9 through 12 may be transported in a <u>multifunction school-activity</u> multi-function school-activity bus (MFSAB) as defined in Section 1-148.3a-5

entity listed in subsection (a) of Section 1-182 of this Code must be transported in a school bus or a vehicle described in subdivision (1) or (2) of subsection (b) of Section 1-182 of this Code for any curriculum-related or college and career readiness school activity, except a student in any of grades 9 through 12 or a student in any of grades K through 12 with an individualized education program Individualized Education Plan (IEP) with a staff to student ratio of 1 to 5, and attending Acacia Academy, Alexander Leigh, Marklund, Helping Hands Center, Connections Organization, Soaring Eagle Academy, or New Horizon Academy may be transported in a multifunction school-activity multi-function school activity bus (MFSAB) as defined in Section 1-148.3a-5 of this Code for curriculum-related or college and career readiness activity except for transportation on regular bus routes from home to school or from school to home, subject to the following conditions:

- (i) A MFSAB may not be used to transport students under this Section unless the driver holds a valid school bus driver permit.
- 21 (ii) The use of a MFSAB under this Section is subject 22 to the requirements of Sections 6-106.11, 6-106.12, 23 12-707.01, 13-101, and 13-109 of this Code.

"Curriculum-related school or college and career readiness activity" as used in this subsection (a) includes transportation from home to school or from school to home,

tripper or shuttle service between school attendance centers, transportation to a college, university, student job site developed through a partnership with the school, vocational or career center or other trade-skill development site or a regional safe school or other school-sponsored alternative learning program, a college or career fair, or a trip that is directly related to the regular curriculum of a student for which he or she earns credit, or an experience that the school determines will contribute to the college or career readiness of the student.

(b) Every student enrolled in grade 12 or below in any entity listed in subsection (a) of Section 1-182 of this Code who is transported in a vehicle that is being operated by or for a public or private primary or secondary school, including any primary or secondary school operated by a religious institution, for an interscholastic, interscholastic-athletic, or school-sponsored, noncurriculum-related activity that (i) does not require student participation as part of the educational services of the entity and (ii) is not associated with the students' regular class-for-credit schedule shall transport students only in a school bus or vehicle described in subsection (b) of Section 1-182 of this Code. This subsection (b) does not apply to any second division vehicle used by an entity listed in subsection (a) of Section 1-182 of this Code for a parade, homecoming, or a similar noncurriculum-related school
