#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

15 ILCS 305/21 new  
20 ILCS 5/5-730 new  
20 ILCS 405/405-535 new

Amends the Secretary of State Act. Provides that in addition to any form of identification which may be issued by the Secretary of State, a municipal identification card shall be considered an acceptable secondary form of identification. Amends the Departments of State Government Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois. Provides that for applications for services as may be provided by any department created under the Code, a municipal identification card shall be considered an acceptable secondary form of identification if such identification is required by an applicable department. Amends the Department of Central Management Services Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois. Provides that any State-owned building that requires the display of a State-issued identification card for the purpose of gaining access to the premises shall accept the use of any municipal identification card as an acceptable form of identification for the purpose of entering the premises. Defines "municipal identification card".

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Secretary of State Act is amended by adding  
5 Section 21 as follows:

6 (15 ILCS 305/21 new)

7 Sec. 21. Secondary form of identification. Notwithstanding  
8 any provision of law to the contrary, in addition to any form  
9 of identification which may be issued by the Secretary of  
10 State, including an identification card issued under the  
11 Illinois Identification Card Act or an Illinois driver's  
12 license, a municipal identification card shall be considered  
13 an acceptable secondary form of identification. For the  
14 purposes of this Section, "municipal identification card"  
15 means a photo identification card that is issued by a  
16 municipality in accordance with its ordinances or codes that  
17 consists of the photo, name, and address of the card holder.

18 Section 10. The Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is  
19 amended by adding Section 5-730 as follows:

20 (20 ILCS 5/5-730 new)

21 Sec. 5-730. Acceptable forms of identification for

1 applications. For applications for services as may be provided  
2 by any department created under this Code, a municipal  
3 identification card shall be considered an acceptable  
4 secondary form of identification if such identification is  
5 required by an applicable department. Nothing in this Section  
6 shall be construed as to allow a municipal identification card  
7 to be used as an applicant's primary form of identification.  
8 For the purposes of this Section, "municipal identification  
9 card" means a photo identification card that is issued by a  
10 municipality in accordance with its ordinances or codes that  
11 consists of the photo, name, and address of the card holder.

12 Section 15. The Department of Central Management Services  
13 Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by  
14 adding Section 405-535 as follows:

15 (20 ILCS 405/405-535 new)

16 Sec. 405-535. State building municipal identification card  
17 access. Any State-owned building that requires the display of  
18 a State-issued identification card for the purpose of gaining  
19 access to the premises shall, in addition to other acceptable  
20 forms of identification, accept the use of any municipal  
21 identification card as an acceptable form of identification  
22 for the purpose of entering the premises. For the purposes of  
23 this Section, "municipal identification card" means a photo  
24 identification card that is issued by a municipality in

1 accordance with its ordinances or codes that consists of the  
2 photo, name, and address of the card holder.
