1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2460

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 2460 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is
5 amended by adding Section 5-730 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 5/5-730 new)

7 Sec. 5-730. Acceptable forms of identification for
8 applications. For applications for services as may be provided
9 by any department created under this Code, an Illinois
10 municipal identification card shall be considered an
11 acceptable secondary form of identification if such
12 identification is required by an applicable department.
13 Nothing in this Section shall be construed as to allow a
14 municipal identification card to be used as an applicant's
15 primary form of identification. For the purposes of this
16 Section, "municipal identification card" means a photo

1 identification card that is issued by an Illinois
2 municipality, as defined under Section 1-1-2 of the Illinois
3 Municipal Code, in accordance with its ordinances or codes
4 that consists of the photo, name, and address of the card
5 holder.

6 Section 10. The Department of Central Management Services
7 Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by
8 adding Section 405-535 as follows:

9 (20 ILCS 405/405-535 new)

10 Sec. 405-535. State building municipal identification card
11 access. Any State-owned building that requires the display of
12 a State-issued identification card for the purpose of gaining
13 access to the premises shall, in addition to other acceptable
14 forms of identification, accept the use of any Illinois
15 municipal identification card as an acceptable form of
16 identification for the purpose of entering the premises. An
17 Illinois municipal identification card may not be sufficient
18 to access certain secure areas within the premises and may
19 require additional authorization or identification at the
20 discretion of the premises' security, the Department of
21 Central Management Services, or the user agency.

22 For the purposes of this Section, "municipal
23 identification card" means a photo identification card that is
24 issued by an Illinois municipality, as defined under Section

1 1-1-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code, in accordance with its
2 ordinances or codes that consists of the photo, name, and
3 address of the card holder.".
