

1 AN ACT concerning wireless service.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Department of State Police Law of the Civil  
5 Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by adding Section  
6 2605-52.1 as follows:

7 (20 ILCS 2605/2605-52.1 new)

8 Sec. 2605-52.1. Wireless service provider call location.

9 (a) Upon request of a law enforcement agency or a public  
10 safety answering point on behalf of a law enforcement agency,  
11 a wireless service provider shall provide call location  
12 information concerning the telecommunications device of a user  
13 to the requesting law enforcement agency or public safety  
14 answering point. A law enforcement agency or public safety  
15 answering point may not request information under this Section  
16 unless for the purposes of responding to a call for emergency  
17 services or in an emergency situation that involves the risk  
18 of death or serious physical harm.

19 (b) A wireless service provider may establish protocols by  
20 which the carrier voluntarily discloses call location  
21 information.

22 (c) A claim for relief may not be brought in any court  
23 against any wireless service provider or any other person for

1 providing call location information if acting in good faith  
2 and under this Section.

3 (d) The Illinois State Police shall obtain contact  
4 information from all wireless service providers authorized to  
5 do business in this State to facilitate a request from a law  
6 enforcement agency or a public safety answering point on  
7 behalf of a law enforcement agency for call location  
8 information under this Section. The Illinois State Police  
9 shall disseminate the contact information to each public  
10 safety answering point in this State.
