SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 3930/7.3 new

Amends the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Act. Requires the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority to establish procedures, allocate, and disburse funding received under the federal Victims of Crime Act for the purpose of supporting youth in foster care, as well as prevention services in the child welfare system. Provides for the adoption of rules.

A BILL FOR

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Criminal Justice Information Act
5 is amended by adding Section 7.3 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 3930/7.3 new)

7 Sec. 7.3. Foster care services funding. Pursuant to the
8 powers and duties set forth in subsection (k) of Section 7, the
9 Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority shall
10 establish procedures, allocate, and disburse funding received
11 under the federal Victims of Crime Act for the purpose of
12 supporting youth in foster care, as well as prevention
13 services in the child welfare system, consistent with that
14 Act. The Authority shall adopt rules to implement this
15 Section.
