1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2973

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 2973 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Sports Wagering Act is amended by changing  
5 Section 25-50 as follows:

6 (230 ILCS 45/25-50)

7 Sec. 25-50. Supplier license.

8 (a) The Board may issue a supplier license to a person to  
9 sell or lease sports wagering equipment, systems, or other  
10 gaming items to conduct sports wagering and offer services  
11 related to the equipment or other gaming items and data to a  
12 master sports wagering licensee while the license is active.

13 (b) The Board may adopt rules establishing additional  
14 requirements for a supplier and any system or other equipment  
15 utilized for sports wagering. The Board may accept licensing  
16 by another jurisdiction that it specifically determines to

1 have similar licensing requirements as evidence the applicant  
2 meets supplier licensing requirements.

3 (c) An applicant for a supplier license shall demonstrate  
4 that the equipment, system, or services that the applicant  
5 plans to offer to the master sports wagering licensee conforms  
6 to standards established by the Board and applicable State  
7 law. The Board may accept approval by another jurisdiction  
8 that it specifically determines have similar equipment  
9 standards as evidence the applicant meets the standards  
10 established by the Board and applicable State law.

11 (d) Applicants shall pay to the Board a nonrefundable  
12 license and application fee in the amount of \$150,000. Except  
13 as provided by Section 8.1 of the Illinois Gambling Act, the  
14 initial supplier license shall be issued for 4 years unless  
15 sooner canceled or terminated. After the initial period, the  
16 Board shall renew supplier licenses for additional 4-year  
17 periods unless sooner canceled or terminated. Renewal of a  
18 supplier license shall be granted to a renewal applicant who  
19 has continued to comply with all applicable statutory and  
20 regulatory requirements. Beginning 4 years after issuance of  
21 the initial supplier license, a holder of a supplier license  
22 shall pay a \$50,000 ~~\$150,000 annual~~ license fee for each  
23 additional 4-year renewal period.

24 (e) A supplier shall submit to the Board a list of all  
25 sports wagering equipment and services sold, delivered, or  
26 offered to a master sports wagering licensee in this State, as

1 required by the Board, all of which must be tested and approved  
2 by an independent testing laboratory approved by the Board. A  
3 master sports wagering licensee may continue to use supplies  
4 acquired from a licensed supplier, even if a supplier's  
5 license expires or is otherwise canceled, unless the Board  
6 finds a defect in the supplies.
