SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Amends the Pyrotechnics Use Act. Provides that "consumer fireworks", "display fireworks", and "flame effect" do not include 1.3G fireworks.

1 AN ACT concerning safety.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Pyrotechnic Use Act is amended by changing
Section 1 as follows:

6 (425 ILCS 35/1) (from Ch. 127 1/2, par. 127)

Sec. 1. Definitions. As used in this Act, the following
words shall have the following meanings:

9 "1.3G fireworks" means those fireworks used for 10 professional outdoor displays and classified as fireworks 11 UN0333, UN0334, or UN0335 by the United States Department of 12 Transportation under 49 C.F.R. 172.101.

"Consumer distributor" means any person who distributes, offers for sale, sells, or exchanges for consideration consumer fireworks in Illinois to another distributor or directly to any retailer or person for resale.

"Consumer fireworks" means those fireworks that must comply with the construction, chemical composition, and labeling regulations of the U.S. Consumer Products Safety Commission, as set forth in 16 C.F.R. Parts 1500 and 1507, and classified as fireworks UN0336 or UN0337 by the United States Department of Transportation under 49 C.F.R. 172.101. "Consumer fireworks" shall not include <u>1.3G fireworks;</u> snake

or glow worm pellets; smoke devices; trick noisemakers known 1 2 "party poppers", "booby traps", "snappers", "trick as matches", "cigarette loads", and "auto burglar alarms"; 3 sparklers; toy pistols, toy canes, toy guns, or other devices 4 5 in which paper or plastic caps containing twenty-five hundredths grains or less of explosive compound are used, 6 7 provided they are so constructed that the hand cannot come in 8 contact with the cap when in place for the explosion; and toy 9 pistol paper or plastic caps that contain less than twenty 10 hundredths grains of explosive mixture; the sale and use of 11 which shall be permitted at all times.

12 "Consumer fireworks display" or "consumer display" means 13 the detonation, ignition, or deflagration of consumer 14 fireworks to produce a visual or audible effect.

15 "Consumer operator" means an adult individual who is 16 responsible for the safety, setup, and discharge of the 17 consumer fireworks display and who has completed the training 18 required in Section 2.2 of this Act.

19 "Consumer retailer" means any person who offers for sale, 20 sells, or exchanges for consideration consumer fireworks in 21 Illinois directly to any person with a consumer display 22 permit.

23 "Display fireworks" means 1.36 or special effects 24 fireworks or as further defined in the Pyrotechnic Distributor 25 and Operator Licensing Act. "Display fireworks" does not 26 <u>include 1.3G fireworks.</u>

effect" the detonation, ignition, 1 "Flame means or deflagration of flammable gases, liquids, or special materials 2 3 to produce a thermal, physical, visual, or audible effect before the public, invitees, or licensees, regardless of 4 5 whether admission is charged, in accordance with National Fire Protection Association 160 guidelines, and as may be further 6 defined in the Pyrotechnic Distributor and Operator Licensing 7 8 Act. "Flame effect" does not include 1.3G fireworks.

9 "Lead pyrotechnic operator" means an individual who is 10 responsible for the safety, setup, and discharge of the 11 pyrotechnic display or pyrotechnic service and who is licensed 12 pursuant to the Pyrotechnic Distributor and Operator Licensing 13 Act.

14 "Person" means an individual, firm, corporation, 15 association, partnership, company, consortium, joint venture, 16 commercial entity, state, municipality, or political 17 subdivision of a state or any agency, department, or instrumentality of the United States and any officer, agent, 18 19 or employee of these entities.

"Production company" means any person in the film, digital 20 and video media, television, commercial, music, or theatrical 21 22 industry who provides pyrotechnic services stage or 23 pyrotechnic display services as part of a film, digital and video media, television, commercial, music, or theatrical 24 25 production in the State of Illinois and is licensed by the 26 Office pursuant to the Pyrotechnic Distributor and Operator

1 Licensing Act.

Pyrotechnic display" means the detonation, ignition, or deflagration of display fireworks or flame effects to produce visual or audible effects of an exhibitional nature before the public, invitees, or licensees, regardless of whether admission is charged, and as may be further defined in the Pyrotechnic Distributor and Operator Licensing Act.

8 "Pyrotechnic distributor" means any person who distributes 9 display fireworks for sale in the State of Illinois or 10 provides them as part of a pyrotechnic display service in the 11 State of Illinois or provides only pyrotechnic services and is 12 licensed by the Office pursuant to the Pyrotechnic Distributor 13 and Operator Licensing Act.

14 "Pyrotechnic service" means the detonation, ignition, or 15 deflagration of display fireworks, special effects, or flame 16 effects to produce a visual or audible effect.

17 "Special effects fireworks" means pyrotechnic devices used for special effects by professionals in the performing arts in 18 conjunction with theatrical, musical, or other productions 19 20 similar consumer fireworks that are to in chemical compositions and construction, but are not intended for 21 22 consumer use and are not labeled as such or identified as 23 "intended for indoor use". "Special effects fireworks" are classified as fireworks UN0431 or UN0432 by the United States 24 Department of Transportation under 49 C.F.R. 172.101. 25
