SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 4108/10

Amends the Local Journalism Task Force Act. Adds additional members to be appointed by the Governor to the Local Journalism Task Force within 30 days after effective date of the amendatory Act.

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Local Journalism Task Force Act is amended
- 5 by changing Section 10 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 4108/10)
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2024)
- 8 Sec. 10. Membership.
- 9 (a) The Task Force shall include the following members:
- one member of the House of Representatives appointed by the
- 11 Speaker of the House of Representatives; one member of the
- 12 House of Representatives appointed by the Minority Leader of
- 13 the House of Representatives; one member of the Senate
- 14 appointed by the President of the Senate; one member of the
- 15 Senate appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate; and one
- member appointed by the Governor.
- 17 (b) The Task Force shall also include the following
- 18 members appointed by the Governor: one representative of the
- 19 Chicago News Guild; one representative of the Chicago Chapter
- 20 of the National Association of Broadcast Employees and
- 21 Technicians-Communication Workers of America; one
- 22 representative of the Medill School of Journalism, Media,
- 23 Integrated Marketing Communications at Northwestern

University; one representative of the Public Affairs Reporting 2 Program at the University of Illinois at Springfield; one representative of the School of Journalism at Southern 3 4 Illinois University Carbondale; one representative of the 5 Illinois Press Association; one representative of the Illinois 6 Broadcasters Association; one representative of the Illinois Legislative Correspondents Association; one representative of 7 the Illinois Public Broadcasting Council; one representative 8 9 of the Illinois News Broadcasters Association: one 10 representative of the University of Illinois at 11 Urbana-Champaign; representative of the Chicago one 12 Independent Media Alliance; one representative of the National 13 Association of Black Journalists; one representative of the 14 Association of LGBTQ Journalists; one representative of the National Association of Hispanic Journalists; 15 representative of the Asian American Journalists Association; 16 17 one representative of the Native American Journalists Association; and one representative of the Illinois Municipal 18 19 League. 20 (c) Appointments shall be made no later than 30 days following the effective date of this Act.
