## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for grants to the Illinois Humanities Council for purposes of: (i) providing aid to humanities nonprofit organizations serving traditionally disenfranchised communities through general operating grants, training, and capacity building; and (ii) increasing statewide access to humanities-based education and free public programming for all Illinoisans in the form of college-credit-bearing courses for income eligible adults, exhibits, and public dialogue programs that foster civic engagement. Effective July 1, 2022.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The amount of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as 4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 5 to the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for 6 grants to the Illinois Humanities Council for purposes of: (i) 7 8 providing aid to humanities nonprofit organizations serving 9 traditionally disenfranchised communities through operating grants, training, and capacity building; and (ii) 10 11 increasing statewide access to humanities-based education and 12 free public programming for all Illinoisans in the form of college-credit-bearing courses for income eligible adults, 13 14 exhibits, and public dialogue programs that foster civic 15 engagement.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2022.
