

## 102ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2021 and 2022 SB3744

Introduced 1/21/2022, by Sen. Ram Villivalam

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

75 ILCS 16/1-60 new 30 ILCS 805/8.46 new

Amends the Public Library District Act of 1991. Provides that, no later than one year after the effective date of the amendatory Act and thereafter, a district must maintain staffing levels of at least the number of staff members required by Appendix 3.2 of the "Serving Our Public: Standards for Illinois Public Libraries", Revised Edition (Copyright 1997 by the Illinois Library Association). Amends the State Mandates Act to require implementation without reimbursement. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Public Library District Act of 1991 is amended by adding Section 1-60 as follows:

- Sec. 1-60. Staffing. No later than one year after the

- 14 Section 90. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding
- 15 Section 8.46 as follows:

- 17 Sec. 8.46. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and
- 18 8 of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for
- 19 the implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory
- 20 Act of the 102nd General Assembly.

- 1 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 2 becoming law.
