2	AMENDMENT NO Amend Senate Bill 4006 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4	"Section 5. The Autism Spectrum Disorders Reporting Act is
5	amended by adding Sections 32 and 33 as follows:
6	(410 ILCS 201/32 new)
7	Sec. 32. Reporting; access to applied behavior analysis.
8	By no later than December 31 of each year the Department of
9	Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) shall submit a report,
10	covering the State fiscal year immediately preceding that
11	date, to the General Assembly regarding access to applied
12	behavior analysis therapy for persons diagnosed with autism
13	spectrum disorder. The report shall include, but is not
14	limited to, the following information:
15	(1) The number of providers enrolled in the Illinois
16	Medical Assistance Program certified to provide applied

behavioral analysis therapy services in the Department of
Healthcare and Family Services' fee-for-service or managed
care service delivery system, in accordance with
administrative rule and Department of Healthcare and
Family Services policy.

6 <u>(2) The number of HFS-enrolled children in Illinois</u> 7 <u>with an autism spectrum disorder diagnosis receiving</u> 8 <u>applied behavior analysis therapy services pursuant to the</u> 9 <u>Department of Healthcare and Family Services'</u> 10 fee-for-service or managed care service delivery system.

11 <u>(3) Subject to data availability, the number of</u> 12 <u>HFS-enrolled children with an autism spectrum disorder</u> 13 <u>diagnosis for whom applied behavioral analysis therapy</u> 14 <u>services have been recommended or requested, but who are</u> 15 <u>not receiving applied behavioral analysis therapy</u> 16 services.

17 <u>(4) Subject to data availability for HFS-enrolled</u> 18 <u>children in Illinois with an autism spectrum disorder</u> 19 <u>diagnosis, the number of prior authorization service</u> 20 <u>denials for applied behavioral analysis therapy services</u> 21 <u>and the number of appeals resulting from those denials for</u> 22 <u>applied behavioral analysis therapy services.</u>

23 (5) Recommendations on improving applied behavioral
24 analysis therapy provider network adequacy and enrollee
25 access.

2	Sec. 33. Education and outreach materials; autism spectrum
3	disorder. The Department shall develop and distribute
4	education and outreach materials, developed to address common
5	literacy levels, that will inform and educate parents of
6	children with autism spectrum disorder who are enrolled in
7	Medicaid and eligible to receive relevant services and explain
8	how to access those services.".
