SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

410 ILCS 535/20.5

Amends the Vital Records Act. Provides that preparation of a certificate of stillbirth is required after a fetal death that occurs in this State after a gestation period of at least 20 (rather than 26) completed weeks.

AN ACT concerning health.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Vital Records Act is amended by changing
Section 20.5 as follows:

6 (410 ILCS 535/20.5)

7 Sec. 20.5. Certificate of stillbirth.

8 (a) The State Registrar shall prescribe and distribute a 9 form for a certificate of stillbirth. The certificate shall be 10 in the same format as a certificate of live birth prepared 11 under Section 12 and shall be filed in the same manner as a 12 certificate of live birth.

(b) After each fetal death that occurs in this State after 13 14 a gestation period of at least 20 26 completed weeks, the person who files a fetal death certificate in connection with 15 16 that death as required under Section 20 shall, only upon 17 request by the woman who delivered the stillborn fetus, also prepare a certificate of stillbirth. The person shall prepare 18 19 the certificate on the form prescribed and furnished by the 20 State Registrar and in accordance with the rules adopted by 21 the State Registrar.

(c) If the stillborn's parent or parents do not wish toprovide a name for the stillborn, the person who prepares the

1 certificate of stillbirth shall leave blank any references to 2 the stillborn's name.

3 (d) When a stillbirth occurs in this State and the 4 stillbirth has not been registered within one year after the 5 delivery, a certificate marked "delayed" may be filed and 6 registered in accordance with regulations adopted by the State 7 Registrar. The certificate must show on its face the date of 8 registration.

9 (e) In the case of a fetal death that occurred in this 10 State after a gestation period of at least 26 completed weeks 11 and before the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 12 93rd General Assembly, a parent of the stillborn child may 13 request that the person who filed a fetal death certificate in connection with that death as required under Section 20 shall 14 15 also prepare a certificate of stillbirth with respect to the 16 fetus. If a parent of a stillborn makes such a request under 17 this subsection (e), the person who filed a fetal death certificate shall prepare the certificate of stillbirth and 18 19 file it with the designated registrar within 30 days after the 20 request by the parent.
