Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Department of Innovation and Technology for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, as follows:

General Funds	\$ 27,700,000
Other State Funds	<u>\$800,200,000</u>
Total	\$827,900,000

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The sum of \$750,000,000, or so much thereof as  
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Technology  
7 Management Revolving Fund to the Department of Innovation and  
8 Technology for administrative and program expenses, including  
9 prior years' costs.

10 Section 10. The amount of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof  
11 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
12 Fund to the Department of Innovation and Technology for all  
13 costs associated with the Cybersecurity Liaison Program.

14 Section 15. The amount of \$20,000,000, or so much thereof  
15 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
16 Fund to the Department of Innovation and Technology for all  
17 costs associated with the Illinois Century Network and  
18 broadband projects.

19 Section 20. The sum of \$30,200,000, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the DoIT Special  
2 Projects Fund to the Department of Innovation and Technology  
3 for all ordinary and contingent expenses related to addressing  
4 cybersecurity risks and cybersecurity threats as authorized by  
5 Section 70612 of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act,  
6 (IIJA) and any associated federal guidance.

7 Section 25. The sum of \$5,700,000 is appropriated from the  
8 General Revenue Fund to the Department of Innovation and  
9 Technology for deposit into the DoIT Special Projects Fund to  
10 provide matching funds for federal funds received pursuant to  
11 Section 70612 of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act.

12 Section 30. The sum of \$20,000,000, or so much thereof as  
13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the DoIT Special  
14 Projects Fund to the Department of Innovation and Technology  
15 for all ordinary and contingent expenses related to information  
16 technology within the powers and duties of the Department.

17 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
18 2022.
